On the evening of August 9, 1945, Albert Einstein sat in deep sorrow after hearing the news of atomic bombings in Hiroshima and Nagasaki, which had caused unimaginable destruction and loss of life. He looked out at the sunset, feeling as though humanity was drowning in darkness, and reflected on the horrors unleashed by atomic energy. Despite his attempts to find solace in music, his grief was overwhelming. He recalled how he had urged President Roosevelt to use the atomic bomb against Hitler to end the war, only to see his invention misused, turning scientists into agents of destruction. Unable to sleep, he resolved to separate himself from government scientific policies and to establish educational institutions that combined science and spirituality.

Einstein invited notable philosophers and Nobel Prize-winning scientists to inaugurate this institution, paying tribute to Mahatma Gandhi as a symbol of non-violence. He emphasized that without a balance between science and spirituality, humanity would continue to face devastation. During a later meeting with a Japanese delegation, he expressed his remorse and willingness to accept any punishment for the bombings, which touched the hearts of those present.
